

## **Killingworth YPC Players Code of Conduct**

Obligations towards the Game a player should:

Make every effort to develop their own sporting abilities in terms of skill, technique, tactics and stamina.

Give maximum effort and strive for the best possible performance during every game.

Set a positive example for others, particularly young players and supporters.

Avoid all forms of gamesmanship and time wasting.

Do not use abusive or inappropriate language

Obligations towards Your Own Team a player should

Make every effort consistent with Fair Play and the Laws of the Game to help his team win.

Resist any influence, which might or might be seen to bring into question to his commitment to the team winning.

Respect for the Laws of the Game and Competition Rules a player should:

Know and comply with the laws, rules and spirit of the game and the competition rules.

Accept success and failure, victory and defeat, equally

Respect towards Opponents a player should:

Treat opponents with due respect at all times, irrespective of the result of the game.

Safeguard the physical fitness of opponents, avoid violence and aggressive play and help injured opponents.

Respect towards the Match Officials a player should

Accept the decision of the Match Official without protest.

Avoid words or actions, which may mislead a Match Official

Show due respect toward Match Officials.

Respect towards Team Officials a player should

Abide by the instructions of their coach and managers, provided they do not contradict the spirit of this code.

Notify your team manager immediately when you are unable attend games or training sessions.

Show due respect towards the opposing coaches and managers

Obligations towards the Supporters a player should:

Show due respect to the interests of supporters

Respect and Care of Club Equipment and Premises a player should:

The correct kit must be worn during training and matches.

Clean kit & boots are essential and shin guards must be worn at all times.

Team kit is only to be worn on match days and any players observed wearing team kit without permission would be disciplined.

The Payment of Subscriptions a player should:

Pay subs to the managers on the agreed date.

Inform the manager of any reason for the non-payment of subs, the club will make every effort to help a player who is unable genuinely pay their subs.

Remember the subs pay the expenses for running the club and any player who continually fails to pay for no genuine reason maybe suspended

Rules for the Use of Killingworth YPC

1. Football Boots are not to be worn in the building
2. Boots are not to be cleaned in the showers
3. Litter is to be placed in the bins

4. Any damaged to the buildings interior is to be noted and Reported to the committee.
5. The managers are responsible for the player's valuables
6. Litter (tape, empty bottles, crisp packets etc) is to be Collected from the pitches after a match and placed in the bins
7. Smoking on the fields is prohibited
- 8 Any violence or improper behavior on or of the pitch when representing KYPC will result in the player involved having his/her membership removed.
9. Any member found drinking alcohol on site will be banned.
